By psychological condition: mental illness, criminal By natural disaster: disaster strikes, poverty, poor housing By social condition: modern slave, homosexual, homelessness By cultural condition: peripheral, racial discrimination.

VULNERABLE

PEOPLE: TEMPORARY/ PERMANENT PHYSICAL – SOCIAL – CULTURAL LOCATION **DIVERSITY: RACE, CULTURE, VALUE, BELIEF, SHARED EXPECTATIONS, AESTHETIC SOCIAL INTERACTION HETEROGENEOUS (VARIED, MIXED) COLLECTION OF HUMAN INDIVIDUALS** SOCIALIZATION.

COMMUNITY

COMMUNITIES ARE GROUPS OF PEOPLE THAT MAY OR MAY NOT BE SPATIALLY CONNECTED, BUT WHO SHARE COMMON INTERESTS, CONCERNS OR IDENTITIES.

- > Dynamics of sharing
- Distribution and redistribution of power through legitimized means
- > Dynamics of authority
- **Equal access to the resources**
- **Freedom**.


EMPOWERMENT









The world's most unequal countries


THE PROCESS OF ENABLING COMMUNITIES TO INCREASE CONTROL OVER THEIR LIVES

CONCEPT OF COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT

Empowerment:

- The process by which people gain control over the factors and decisions that shape their lives.
- It is the process by which they increase their assets and attributes and build capacities to gain access, partners, networks and/or a voice, in order to gain control.
- People cannot "be empowered" by others; they can only empower themselves by acquiring more of power's different forms.

CONTEMPORARY FRAMEWORK



EMPOWERMENT FRAMEWORK

Developed inductively from a corpus of data




